Poodle Club of Canada Code of Ethics



- 1. To conduct myself in a good and sportsmanlike manner as required by the Canadian Kennel Club
- 2. To abide by the Canadian Kennel Club's rules and regulations.
- 3. To strive for the betterment of the Poodle breed and for the control/eradication of hereditary problems particular to the breed.
- 4. To never sell puppies to pet shops. It is preferred all pet puppies be sold on Non-breeding agreements.
- 5. To represent my dogs as honestly as possible to prospective buyers and assist them with advice on diet, vaccinations and general health care.
- 6. To keep my dogs under conditions as described in " <u>A Code of Practice for Canadian Kennel Operations</u> " written by the Canadian Veterinary Association.
- 7. To accept with dignity the cancellation of my membership should my actions contradict the aforesaid.
- 8. Executive Members and Directors of the Club shall refrain from using their Board position on any correspondence, advertising, emails or web pages (either personal or professional) other than that pertaining to official Club business.
