Poodle Club of Canada Western Regional Specialty & Obedience Trial Results

October 12, 2006 in Camrose, Alberta – what a great day it was! The Organizing Committee of the PCC Western Regional Specialty Show and Obedience Trial for all poodles held a very successful event.

Obedience Judging

The day started with obedience judge Terry Gains directing 16 dog-owner teams in the regular obedience classes followed by 11 entries in the unofficial classes. High in Trial with a score of 196.5 from the Open B class was the Standard poodle OTCH Alias Lovely Lacee owned by Gale Downie. Lacee also won high score in the Utility class.

The Novice A winner, with a score of 180.5 was the Standard poodle Pinafore Smash Hit owned by Pat Moffat. Miniature poodle White Crest On A Mission owned by Kathleen Charlton took high score in Novice B with 190.5. The Open A high scoring dog was Standard poodle Ch Seransil Ripitup At Skyewell, CD, CGN owned by Shirley and Robyn DeJager.

The Veterans class was won by Miniature poodle Ch GMOTCH Quillstone Casey Jones Am UD owned by Lee Kozicki. Lee's other Miniature poodle Ch MOTCH Claydon's Crunch and Munch took the Versatility class and together these two minis teamed up to win the Brace class.

Sweepstakes Judging

Conformation judging began with well-known breeder/handler Murray Eason evaluating 20 Sweepstakes entries. Best in Sweepstakes was awarded to the senior puppy female winner, Standard poodle, Seransil Walking On Sunshine owned by Heather and John Bolen and Evelyn Sera. Best Opposite Sex in Sweepstakes went to the Standard poodle winner of the senior puppy male class, Seransil Luke At Me owned by Evelyn Sera.

Best Veteran in Sweepstakes was awarded, during a standing ovation, to the 13 year old Standard poodle Ch Dawin Remarkable Discovery, CD owned and shown by Donna McLaughlin. Best in Breeder Sweepstakes was presented to Standard poodle Can Am Ch Seransil Simply the Best and Best Opposite Sex in Breeder Sweepstakes went to Standard poodle Ch Seransil Faith'N Angels.

Sweepstakes Judge's Critique

"Firstly I want to thank all the Poodle Club of Canada members that worked so hard in putting on a truly spectacular Regional show. It was truly a great pleasure to judge puppies and veteran sweepstakes and everyone is to be commended. I thought it was great having the show on Thursday before the all breed as I found it to be more relaxed and less hectic.

Junior Puppy Females

1st place Insync Isabella #60 lovely moving Standard puppy short back, nice feet, very well balanced.

2nd place Sharona's Kiss Me Kate #37 short back Miniature poodle, nice side picture, pretty head, could use her front better and would have liked to have seen better feet.

Senior Puppy Males

1st place Seransil Luke At Me #55 white Standard poodle, good pigment, nice feet, could be more settled on the down and back.

Senior Puppy Females

1st place Seransil Walking on Sunshine #66 white Standard female pretty head and expression, lovely pigment, nice feet, very easy on her legs, beautiful side picture, kept getting better as she moved, very balanced and beautiful type.

2nd place Seransil Skyewell Island Time #62 beautiful head piece, lovely face, a little loose in front not as easy on her legs as my 1st place dog.

Female Yearling

1st place Lezerin's Provocative Woman #39 Silver beige Miniature lovely colour, good mover, nice feet, could use more refined head and a better tailset.

My Best in Sweepstakes was ultimately the white Standard Poodle females from the senior puppy class #66. She is a bitch of beautiful make and shape; a lovely mover that demands your attention. She has lovely balance and is very correct in her movement; she gained confidence with every step that she took. She was truly a bitch of great quality that appealed to me very much. She went on to be Best of Winners and Best Puppy in Specialty.

Best of Opposite in Sweepstakes was #55 white Standard male from the senior puppy class. Lovely head and expression, good pigment, nice feet, not as good on the move as my ultimate winner.

Veteran Males

Ch Dawin Remarkable Discovery CD #88 Lovely moving dog still at his age, great carriage and presence, pleasing head and expression.

Breeder Sweepstakes

1st place Seransil Simply the Best #76 Tall white Standard; lovely mover with good reach and drive, nice feet and great coat texture.

Best Opposite in Breeder's Sweepstakes Seransil Skyewell Faith'N Angels #89 White Standard, short back, nice feet, could use a better rear, very unsettled on the go around."

Conformation Judging

Specialty judge, Mr. William Cunningham, began judging by evaluating the 13 Miniature poodle entries. He chose Tyramara's Four On The Floor, owned and bred by Denise Brandsma, as his Winners Male. Winners Female, Best of Winners and Best Bred by Exhibitor was Rosebell's First Sight owned by Elaine

and Heidi Bellamy. Best of Variety and Best Puppy was presented to the Specials female Forever Summer Mist Raven Ice owned by Olesa Mondell and Jennifer Manders. Best Opposite Sex was awarded to Ch Abmaka Kandansk Fast N Furious owned by Kathryn Albrecht and Natasha Taphorn.

The 36 Standard poodle entries were up next. Winners Male from the Junior Puppy class was Lumiere Carrington Hot Hot Hot owned by Natalie Lasanen; Winners Female, Best of Winners and Best Puppy was awarded to Seransil Walking on Sunshine owned by Heather and John Bolen and Evelyn Sera. Best of Variety was captured by Am Can Ch Alias Just Give Me That Wink owned by Lynne and Teri Taplin with Best Opposite Sex being presented to Am Can Ch Carrington's Just So You Know owned by Dianne Hopper. An Award of Merit was presented to Am Can Ch Pinafore Cadance owned by Kim Cowie and Penny Harney.

Mr. Cunningham then proceeded to the 6 Toy entries. Winners Male, Best Bred by Exhibitor, Best of Winners and Best Puppy were awarded to Innovation's Superman owned by Shaunna Bernardin and Beth Bujea. Winners Female and Best Opposite Sex was won by Cindmisty's Jazzamataz owned by Brenda Lee. Best of Variety was handed to Ch Baliwick Bailey Banks Blithe owned by Barbara Conley and Ianthe Bloomquist.

After a short break, Mr. Cunningham and his winning dogs and owners returned to the ring for Best in Specialty judging. His ultimate choice for Best in Specialty was the black Standard Poodle Am Can Ch Alias Just Give Me That Wink; Best Opposite Sex was the Standard Am Can Ch Carrington's Just So You Know; Best Puppy in Specialty was the Standard Seransil Walking on Sunshine; and Best Bred by Exhibitor was Toy Poodle Innovation's Superman.

In the unofficial classes, Best Stud Dog and Get was awarded to Standard Poodle Ch Telescombe Ri'Backatya Seransil owned by Evelyn Sera; Best Dam and Progeny was awarded to Standard Poodle Can Am Ch Seransil Sculptured Angel owned by Evelyn Sera.

Other Highlights

Later that evening a well-attended buffet banquet was held at the host hotel. All three judges expressed their pleasure at being offered their assignment to participate in the PCC Western Regional. Hospitality and several hours of fellowship were the only order of business.

The following evening, Mr. Cunningham presented a seminar entitled "The Poodle" which covered correct body structure and movement, as well as faults in the breed.
