DOGS AND HOT CARS DON'T MIX

A parked car can quickly become deadly- hot for a dog shut inside.

Facts

- Even with the windows partly opened- and even on a cloudy day – a car's interior can climb to 120 degrees or higher within minutes.
- With only hot air to breathe, a dog's normal process of cooling through panting fails.
- A body temperature of just 107 degrees may cause brain damage or death from heatstroke.

Signs of heat stress include

- Heavy panting, glazed eyes, vomiting, dizziness or listlessness.

Emergency first aid for heat- stressed dogs

- Apply tepid –not cold – water all over the dog's body, or immerse in tepid water. Gradually apply cooler water to lower the body temperature. Seek immediate veterinary care.

If you see an animal enclosed in a car on a hot day, act immediately by calling the nearest police officer or animal control department.

Does Your Poodle Qualify for a Versatility Award?

Think You Have What It Takes

Since June 2001 there have been over 30 Versatility Awards given out to Poodle Club of Canada members and their Poodles. All three varieties of Poodles are eligible. There are three levels of awards available:

All-Round Poodle

A minimum of two titles in two separate activities.

The Award consists of a certificate suitable for framing.

Working Poodle

A minimum of two separate titles, one of which must be beyond the first level of competition.

The Award consists of a plaque.

Versatile Poodle

A Championship or highest level in one discipline plus two additional titles in two separate activities.

The Award consists of a plaque and a silver medallion.

Why a Versatility Award?

Why place such emphasis on the versatility of Poodles? Well the answer is quite simply that versatility is the Poodle's heritage. There are very few breeds that can match the Poodle for the variety of tasks that they have been asked to perform. They have been hunting dogs, herding dogs, truffle dogs, circus dogs, police dogs, show dogs, obedience dogs, tracking dogs, agility dogs, guide dog and special skills dogs. That list of diverse tasks has made the Poodle the wonderful versatile dog that it is today. let us celebrate and reward this rich background because there is only one dog that can do it all and do it with flair, humour, beauty and style the Poodle!

How does the application process work?

You can apply for any level of award - you do not have to start with the All-Round Poodle -if you have met all the requirements for a higher level you can apply for that one.

You will need to complete an application (available for download on the Poodle Club of Canada web site) and send it, along with copies of the relevant titling information, a short bio of your Poodle and any photographs, to the Versatility Chair. You may also contact the Chair if you have any questions about the program.

PCC Rally Obedience Trials

The Poodle Club of Canada held its first ever Rally Obedience trials on May 31 and June 1, 2008 at Pine Point Arena in Etobicoke, Ontario. The Rally Trials were held in conjunction with the Swansea Dog Obedience Club's annual obedience trials.

Judges Bonnie Christie and Ted Leslie were stupendous – keeping everything on track and giving challenging but fun courses for the exhibitors. There were over a dozen competitors who completed titles and they received titling rosettes. The novice entrants particularly appreciated this gesture. Each qualifying team received their Q ribbon, scoresheet and a small toy once their run was complete and scored by the judge. Then the top 4 teams (based on time) were called back into the ring to receive placement rosettes.

On Saturday we offered a High Scoring Poodle award, sponsored by Susan Fraser of Bibelot, in memory of her first Poodle, *Ch Barlanark Lisette UD*. The award was presented to Renee Koch with her Standard Poodle, Piper, from the Novice A class with a perfect score of 100!

On Sunday the High Scoring Poodle award was sponsored by Roslyn Beaman in memory of her first Poodle, *Sigma Chi's White Delight CKC CD AgN, NAFA FMCH, AAC VMADC and AADC, NADAC EJC, EAC-V, NGC-V, AKC AX, Poodle Club of Canada Versatile Poodle, VIP VCX, PCA Working Certificate*. The award was won by Cheryl Ingwersen with her Standard Poodle, Rook, from the Advanced B class, also with a perfect score of 100 and what was the fastest time of the day!

There were lots of volunteers – Table Steward, Vivienne Swarbreck who ran the head table like a professional all weekend. David Pateman was Chief Ring Steward and ran his team like clockwork, and pitched in as Honour Judge for the Excellent level of classes to judge the dog and handler team who had to honour while another competitor ran the course. Cheryl Ingwersen was our Timer on Saturday, and a totally newbie to any dog sport, Stephen Kropf, was our Timer on Sunday. Gate/Ring Stewards were Dawn Nagata, Nicole Koch, Renee Koch and Rosie Van Bemmell, and another totally newbie to dog events, Lori Tobis, who doesn't even own a dog! Kudos to the team for representing The Poodle Club so well – both judges, and competitors were complimentary to everyone.
