The Vetran Dog by Cheryl Cazier

In the 24 hours since the following occurred, I can hardly believe the outpouring of comments and feelings that it has evoked. It all began 6 months ago and came to a head when I attended yesterday's meeting of our local breed club. This incident caused me much heartfelt pain that it made me wonder why I should "even bother". I came close to not renewing my membership - and I am a founding member of this club. To be perfectly honest, the ONLY reason I renewed was because I am the Rescue Coordinator for the club. And I had not attended a meeting since "what happened" happened.

I wasn't even going to attend the meeting until I noticed when checking the entries on-line that there was a certain lone entry listed... I knew then that I must attend and I must finally speak my mind...and my heart.

I sat down at my computer and carefully composed my thoughts. Tears came to my eyes as I wrote it and I feared that I could not read it aloud to the membership. And that was the case. As the President called out a request for "meeting adjourned", I stood up and said "I have one

more thing" and handed the copy to a good friend who was seated next to me. I'm afraid I won't be able to read this to you all, but if Lynda



would, I'd appreciate it."

(As they say: "All names and breed have been changed to protect the innocent". I can't honestly say that anyone concerned in this incident is innocent, but the purpose of this is not to further embarrass anyone involved. This, BTW, did not occur at a Specialty, just at an All-Breed Show, in a non-regular class.)

The following is what I wrote:

"I see that the *Smiths* have entered their dog in the Veterans Class. Apparently there is no one in this Club who knows that it is customary to offer a round of applause for those that are entered. Six

months ago, at this same show, I entered my Veteran Dog in this same class.

Not one person applauded.

Not one person came up and said anything.

Not one person came over to give him a kind word or a pat.

Not one person made him feel he belonged again.

He was no threat to anyone. He wasn't going to beat anyone, take any points, or win anything. He was just an old dog who thought he was special again back in the ring for the first time in many years. Maybe he even recalled his "Glory Days".

He would have loved to have met anyone there. He would have welcomed you like an old friend.

You didn't have to say anything nice about him if you didn't want to.

But just in case you can't think of anything to say about a Veteran Dog, here are some suggestions: "It was nice to see him out there". Or go up to him and tell him he's a "Good Boy". Or tell his owner that you are glad that they

brought him. Those aren't exactly compliments, but they will please his owner and make him glad that they brought him. I don't think that's asking too much.

One day, all too soon, all your beautiful young dogs will be old dogs too. Maybe one day you'll enter them in a Veterans Class. And I hope that you do. Or, like many of us, you remember that old friend, now gone, and wish you still had the chance. They deserve it. It may be their final time in the suntheir last time out in front of people. Their last time to ever be in the ring.

My old dog is a Fool. He thought he was wonderful that day. He thought he belonged.

Instead, he was ignored.

I have thought about his for 6 months now, and

this for 6 months now, and wasn't going to say anything. But on his behalf, and that of any other Veteran, I hope that something like this never occurs again. As a Club of (Breed) Fanciers, you should feel ashamed. Even if you dislike the dog or his owner, at least show Good Sportsmanship and do the Right Thing. Show others that you have respect for your breed.

Make that Veteran Dog feel wanted and special again. Let him know that you are glad to see him. It will make his day. You may never get the chance again. Thank you."

As Lynda began reading it, the hush that fell over the room was incredible. Bless her heart, my friend Lynda broke into tears as she struggled through reading this. EVERYONE in the room lowered their heads, and many of them began to cry also, including the President (who is a man). I tried my best to hold my head up and refrain from tears, again. The President strode over to where I was sitting and in a voice broken "Terry......I am SO sorry. He is such a wonderful dog. There is no excuse for what happened to you. And to him."

As I started to say that I "wasn't going to say anything" again, the room nearly burst with everyone trying to talk at once. The discussion that followed was both eye-opening and of valuable purpose. Many came up to me in tears, with hugs and apologies.

I am a very private and shy person, not given to sharing my deepest feelings easily. This had been an incredibly difficult thing for me to do, but in honor of my Veteran and all the others out there, I felt it must be done.

Was it worth it?

When *Mr. Smith* took his lovely 12 1/2 year old dog (neutered due to testicular cancer) into the ring, our entire membership remained and applauded and "whooped and hollered" him with every move. The Judge moved to the center of the ring on his final go round and applauded, as did her ring stewards. Others nearby, watching other breeds, came over and remarked on how wonderful it was to see a Veteran being treated like that. Many (including me) asked to take his picture. Everyone complimented him and his owners.

If only my old dog had enjoyed such a day...

Was it worth it? You tell me...

Sorry for the length of this, but so many in other breeds who heard about what happened have already asked me for a copy of my written paper that I thought perhaps it was something that needed to be shared. Amazing how quickly word spreads amongst us dog people. It's often said "You

can't teach an old dog new tricks". But I know one old dog who taught something of great value.

Recipe Corner

food for the canine companion

Fox Run Dog Biscuits

Serving size: approximately 20 biscuits.

Ingredients

21/2 cup whole wheat flour

6 Tbsp. margarine or oil

½ cup nonfat dry milk powder

1 egg

tsp. sugar

2/3 cup cold water

1 tsp. salt

Combine dry ingredients and mix well. Add the remaining ingredients and stir with a wooden spoon to form a stiff dough. Alternately, combine all ingredients in a food processor and process until dough forms. Roll out to a thickness of about ½ inch; cut into dog bone shapes with dog bone cutters or into sticks about three inches long and 3/4 inch wide. Bake on an un-greased baking sheet for 25 minutes in a 350 oven. Cool on a rack, then store in an airtight container.

Canine Massage Therapy by Tracey Downey, REMT

You've noticed recently that Sparky just isn't his old self. Ever since last weekend's family reunion, when he spent all afternoon running with the kids, he's been a little stiff. Since he's usually such a couch potato, you thought it would be good for him to get out. Now you realize that he may have done too much, and now he's paying for it. Your friend at work has suggested that you call a canine massage therapist, but you're not sure. Will it help? Is it the right time for massage? So many questions, but where to find the answers?

In this article, we'll look at canine massage therapy, from the beginning - calling the therapist - to the end of the first session. There are three general reasons to use canine massage: for relax-

ation, for therapeutic or rehabilitative purposes, and for optimizing performance at an event. For the purpose of this article, Sparky falls into the therapeutic or rehabilitave massage category. This particular category refers to dogs who have sustained an injury, or need a specific body malfunction corrected.

So, now that we've decided what category Sparky is in at the moment, we should call the canine massage therapist, right? Wrong! Any massage therapist, for animals or people, cannot diagnose a condition.

Since Sparky has turned up with something new for him, the first person he sees should be his veterinarian. Only a veterinarian can rule out more serious injuries, and give the all clear for a therapist to massage. Remember, anything that has the power to heal has the power to hurt, so it is in your dog's best interest to make sure that massage is right for him.

Once the vet has determined that Sparky could benefit from massage therapy, it is time to call a therapist. You should know that there is no formal training for canine massage therapy anywhere in Canada. That is, you cannot go to a college or university and earn a degree in Canine Massage Therapy. This does not mean that there are no qualified Canine Massage Therapists out there; in fact, quite the opposite is true. It simply means

that all Canine Massage Therapists will come from different backgrounds and experiences. You should not be afraid to ask questions before committing to a massage session. How long they have been working with dogs, and why they chose to work with dogs in the first place will give you an idea of the personality of the therapist. Good Canine Massage Therapists have certain things in common. They should hold the best interests of the dog in high priority. They should have formal training in Massage Finally, they should Therapy. not be afraid to communicate with the attendingveterinarian. Your therapist will probably want to discuss the dog's background with the vet, so that they are as informed as possible about the animal's medical background.

There are other things the therapist may ask in the phone conversation preceding the massage session. The therapist will want to know how the injury or malfunciton occurred in detail. He or she will also want to know about Sparky's regular life activities; this will help them to understand Sparky and his way of life. If Sparky is particularly upset by anything - people wearing ball caps, loud talking, red shirts, whatever - this would be the time to mention it. It is not a fair test of a therapist's dog handling abilities to not mention it and see if Sparky will bite them!

There are two possibilities for Sparky's upcoming rendezvous. He may go visit the therapist at the therapist's location, or the therapist may come to him. As a therapist myself, I tend to go to the dog's home as I feel he will be most comfortable there. Wherever the session takes place, it should be quiet, free of distraction, and of a comfortable temperature. It should take place at a time of day when Sparky is not waiting to be fed, or waiting to go for his daily walk. This will help to ensure that Sparky is putting the most attention into the task at hand - the massage!

When the therapist arrives, Sparky should be doing whatever he normally does at that time of day - don't shut him in his crate for the afternoon if he is used to running around, or he will be too energized to enjoy the effects. The first few minutes of the session will probably be spent discussing Sparky's various behaviours and movements. This gives the therapist extra valuable information, and lets Sparky check out the therapist before the therapist has hands all over him.

Some of the things your therapist does may seem odd, or like they have nothing to do with massage at first. They may appear to not be even looking at the dog. Be assured that they are in fact studying the dog, but in such a way as to not put Sparky on the defensive. Remember that when dogs challenge one another, they stare unwavering at the challengee. Your dog's therapist most certainly does not want to give the dog that impression!

Some other things that

may occur that don't necessarily look like massage therapy are gait analysis and Range of Motion assessments. Gait analysis is simply an observation of the way Sparky walks and jogs; or the way he gaits. From this, the therapist can better determine where Sparky's major issues lie. Range of Motion is simply a manipulation of the body's joints, to see if they are restricted or compromised in any way. Both of these observational tools are quite common and well within a Massage Therapist's scope of practice.

On to the actual massage. With the dog's comfort in mind, I personally do not like to place dogs on massage tables, no matter how small they are. Dogs have trouble relaxing fully when they are in a position to fall. On the floor, preferably carpetted, is fine; or for little dogs, therapist on the floor and dog on a couch is not quite so overwhelming.

There are a large number of massage techniques which a therapist can use. Some deal directly with the muscles, manually encouraging them to stretch, relax or break down adhesions. Others cause increases in the circulation to the area, which is good because the blood carries oxygen and nutrients and takes away cellular wastes. By encouraging increased circulation, the therapist maximizes this exchange rate and therefore the tissue's overall health. Some techniques are designed to affect only the nerves in an area. These techniques send signals to the nerves that it is time to relax the muscles groups they infuse, or

they can disrupt the pain signal that nerves can send.

Most techniques feel good to the animal. However there are techniques that are more agressive and cause momentary dicomfort while aiding in the restoring of function. Keep in mind that Sparky does not have to appear through the whole massage as though he is in doggy heaven. He may experience moments of discomfort and uncertainty, but you will see an improvement none the less.

You, the owner, are encouraged to stay in the room with the dog while he is having his massage. Knowing you are not far away will help him to relax, and the therapist may observe things in the dog that he or she may want to ask you about. In the interests of keeping the atmosphere quiet, try to remember any questions you have and ask them at the end of the session. If you don't think you can remember, ask away, but try to keep the chatting to a minimum. Most therapists love to talk about what they do, so don't be afraid of your own curiousity. You can also watch your dog for signs that he is

enjoying the session. Licking lips, eyes closing, panting, yawning, sleeping, and offering areas for touch are just some of the ways that Sparky may show his appreciation.

The average session can be anywhere from 25 minutes long to a little over an hour, depending on the size of the dog and his tolerance for massage. Some first timers are ill at ease with that much undivided attention, and need a break after the first 15 minutes!

At the end of the session, the therapist will discuss what he or she has found, and the progress they feel they can make with Sparky. At this time, they will want to set up a regular schedule for the next few weeks, to encourage Sparky back to his healthy self. Depending on the reason for the session, it may be most beneficial to see Sparky twice a week for the first two weeks, before gradually backing down to a once a month maintenance massage. This kind of regime can become quite expensive, and is only a suggestion for the best possible results. A schedule less rigourous than this, albeit not ideal, will still provide

satisfactory results and be easier on the purse strings.

Your therapist will probably call you the next day to see how Sparky is getting along. Keep in mind that Sparky may appear a little stiff or slightly uncomfortable the next day. This is necessarily an adverse reaction to massage. Sparky's body may simply be having trouble processing all the messages that the massage gave it the day before. At the other end of the scale, he may feel wildly better and wish to be very energetic. It will be hard to say no, but you must remember that Sparky is recovering from a form of injury and the body still needs time to Don't overdue it right away. That's how he got there in the first place!

If you have any questions about massage therapy, and still aren't sure about using it on old Sparky, I strongly suggest you go a try a massage for yourself from a Registered Massage Therapist. It is a very non-invasive therapy, and once you feel the difference in yourself, you'll want the same quality of life for your furry best friend!
